Southampton Artist members will receive a discounted rate of \$90. for a single space or \$175 for a double space. A single space is 12 feet by 12 feet and a double is 12 feet by 24 feet. Please remember to be considered a member, your dues must be current and paid for 2010. Membership runs from January to December.

Again, this year, we will have the Southampton Artists Members booth. This is for current paid up members who would like to be part of the show but who do not have a tent or display racks of their own. Cost is the same as last year, \$10 per piece with a maximum of two pieces. Anyone

exhibiting in the members' booth will be required to sit. A timetable with sitting assignments will be made available in advance of the show dates.
