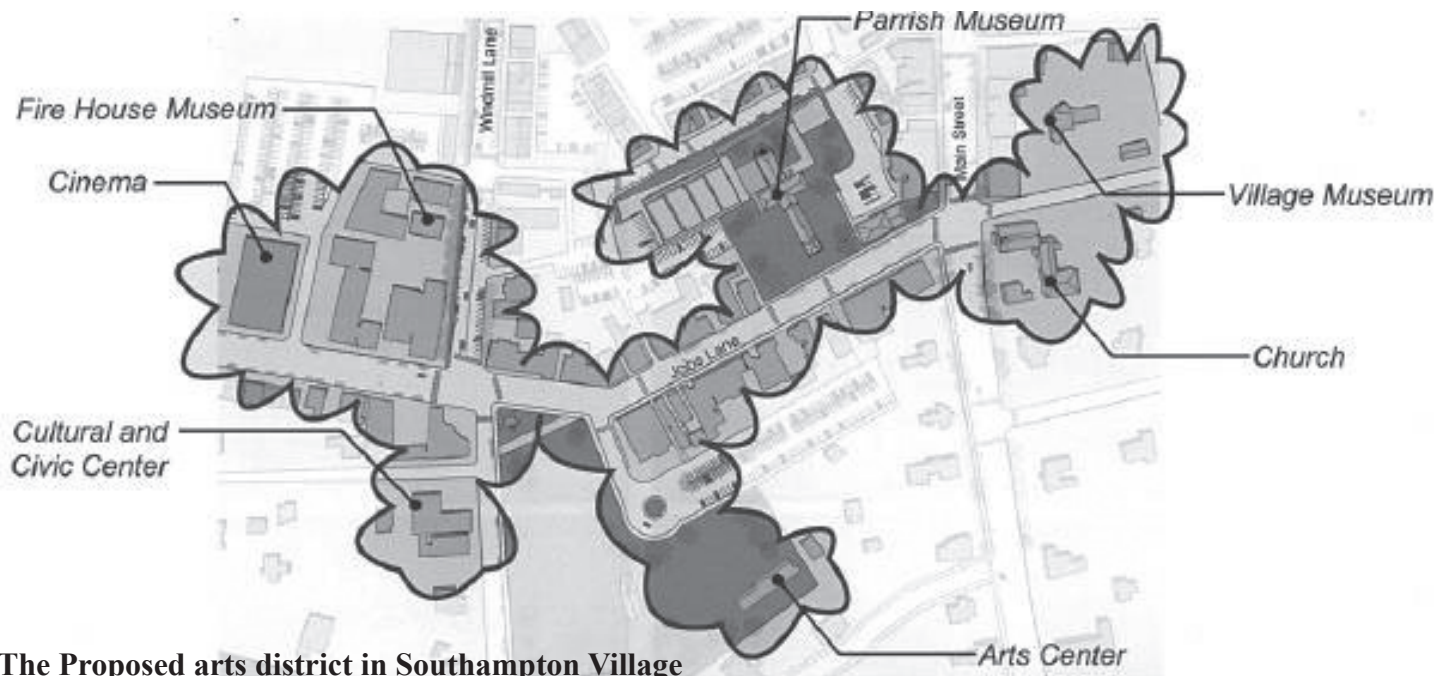

# In other News...



## The Proposed arts district in Southampton Village

The local newspaper: The Southampton Press had a recent article by our friend Pat Rogers in her story of Jerry Saltz, the art critic for The New York Magazine. In her usual lucid manner of reporting Pat shows Mr. Saltz to us clearly and it is this clarity from him I wish to bring to you.

His top of the list for artists is credibility, and explains that having your name counted among exhibitions does not produce this. Your own authenticity of work and artistic convictions will produce this credibility for you. As he extended, "You artists are babies" wanting of some universal notice and whining when it doesn't happen. Be true to yourself and your ideas -- be self-centered and have this evident in your art. Your content will show and your attention to that and the directions it takes is important to the artist. Finding "one dealer, one curator, one critic which might lead to others, and eventually to 10 collectors." Mr. Saltz opines that's all that's needed to achieve your success. This is something you must do for yourself.

Mr. Saltz feels that art is not optional but is a "citadel of culture."

In other matters keep your eye on Southampton. Take a village map and draw a "crazy loop" that encloses the artistic and cultural centers and be aware there are plans and thoughts of a formation of an "Arts District." We are right in the midst of such a district. Without getting too melodramatic your participation as an individual and as an organization has become ever more essential to get out, get snoopy and get involved in some form. Remember the old saying "Success breeds success."

The PAM (Parrish Art Museum) has broken ground in the outskirts of Southampton - Water Mill. They invited and the Governor came to the breaking ceremony. The proposed arts district presently has the PAM centrally located. While the PAM group will be moving to expand this district the Museum itself remains and its new use is still to be determined. I feel as though my 50 years here has been worthwhile. See you at the art show.
